

Our prayer is that as we all join in this **mission**, God will use this spiritual journey to help develop our faith as we expand our **Aircraft Carrier** together!

## ONE FUND

Traditional giving is often separated into categories such as tithes and offerinas, missions, building funds. etc. However. God has not called Restoration to several tasks, but to ONE mission: empowering people to be world-changers by releasing them into their full potential in the Kinadom of God. Everything Restoration does falls under this singular **mission**, from weekend services to specific agegroup gatherings, and from community engagement to missions work.

The Aircraft Carrier initiative is the next chapter in this mission. Therefore, all giving will go into ONE FUND to see the entirety of our mission realized. Every financial gift made will go into the same fund in order to help us continue building a platform for people to land on our campus. learn how to live the way God designed and launch them into the community.

### 1. What is the Aircraft Carrier Initiative?

God is uniquely positioning Restoration to increase our influence for the cause of Jesus through our investment in this three-year initiative, which addresses three critical areas of opportunity. We will expand our campus for more people to **land** by building a 40,000 sq. ft. facility, create space for more people to **learn** how to live out their Ephesians 2:10 calling, and **launch** them outside the walls of Restoration Church.

# 2. Will our church change?

In short, **NO**. We are a church on a mission. The only thing that will change is enhanced ministry opportunities that come with having a larger facility.

# 3. Why do we need a larger building?

Simply put, we are in a high-growth area, and God continues to add to our numbers. We have over 850 adults in our weekly worship services and an average of 250 children. Our classrooms are consistently full. Guests are regularly seated in the lobby for overflow. Many of our ministries are restricted because of our limited space.

# 4. What will children spaces look like?

Our current building will be remodeled to accommodate more children. This new kid's area will incorporate safe spaces designed specifically for each age group in order for them to experience God on their level and in their current stage of life.



# 5. How much will construction and remodeling cost?

We estimate the total cost of this phase to be \$14.25 million, which includes architecture, engineering, construction materials, labor, and everything necessary to begin operating effectively.

# 6. Can we afford this building?

Yes, but we will need to take generosity to a new level. This is an "all-hands-on-deck" initiative, meaning it will depend on our entire congregation's generosity. The goal is to be debt-free at the end of the three-year period. We will be expedient to pay off any debt as quickly as possible, as we desire to continue pouring money into ministry.

# 7. What type of outside help are we receiving for this project?

We have contracted with Studio Red to provide the architectural design of our building. In addition, we have a general contractor for the management of construction.

# 8. How long is the construction process? When will we move in?

The new construction will take roughly 14 months, and the remodel of our current building will take an additional nine months. Our goal is to break ground on the new construction by May 2022, with a move-in date of August 2023. The remodel will be done in sections since it will continue to be used regularly. Its estimated completion is Summer 2024.



# 9. Will there be more construction in the future?

Yes. Our next phase will be an outdoor covered pavilion/basketball court and turfed green space to accommodate large outdoor gatherings.

# 10. What are you asking of me?

We want you to join us on the Restoration journey. Start by praying and asking God for guidance in how He wants you to contribute to this initiative. Gather your family together to discuss what this commitment will mean for the next three years as you follow God's will.
